#### *What happens at Oneida County Teen Court?*

Teen Court panelists hear the facts of a case for defendants who have already pled guilty on minor offenses. They then assign sanctions that must be completed within six months, such as community service hours or writing papers about their offense. Defendants who complete their sanctions do not have to pay fines and have their offenses removed from their records.
