HOW TO RE-ENROLL

The process to re-enroll is quick & easy!

- 1. Log into your 4HOnline account.
- 2. Select the family member to re-enroll.
- 3. Go through each screen and update information as needed.
 - a. Clubs
 - b. Projects: choose a project that closely depicts your childs' interests.
 - c. Questions
 - d. Health Form: this is not a requirement.
 - e. Consents: you must answer all the questions in the Consents section before you can submit re-enrollment.
- 4. After you go through each screen, click the Submit button at the bottom.

Do this for each member enrolled in 4-H that will continue membership in 2023-2024.
