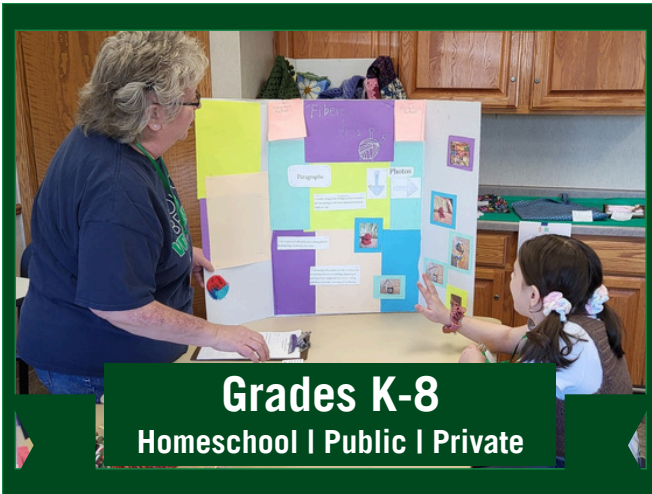

*Cost: \$20/Family*

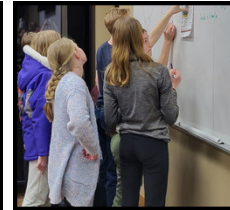
(Fees are to help cover the cost of medals, awards, and refreshments).

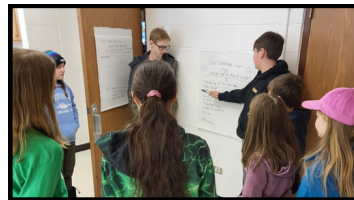
