Oneida County 4-H Junior Leaders Club will be offering a fun family event that will offer variety of activities, including art, fishing, and exploring nature. More information coming soon!

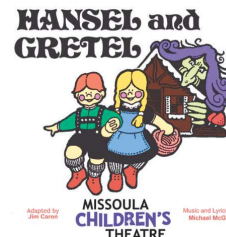
